JD(3)

1 Simister's Cadermist Earl of Igor, DCC.

Dark brindle with a very good head; not fully mature, but; has; good lines, eye shape correct colour could have been darker, it would have been ok in a fawn. A well muscled strong body with good conformation, kept his topline at all times, would have liked more width of thigh, but I am sure this will come as he matures. Very good feet and bone. Sound moving with good reach and drive.

2 Clark's Cyberus Berlington Bertie,

very good bone, feet and width of thigh, not quite as good in front on the move as first, topline could be better but as first they are still got to mature. Sound moving, two promising dogs.

3 Baxter's Maharajah Shera by Nobleheart.

PGD (4) This class was not easy (4)

1 Smith, Dobunni Revolution,

This dog has a very promising head, dark eyes and a very good shape with tight lids. Not the best in front on the move and that is a shame as he has a very strong rear good width of thigh. Body well ribbed back and loin short but the top line a little weak, still young so could improve, he has very good bone.

2 McCulloch & Williams Bredwardine Prince at Damaco.

This dog looked a lot younger, not as mature, better in front other wise very much the same as above.

3 Bowdery, Sherwood's Okie Dokie (imp Usa).

LD (4,1)

1 Pennie's Fearnought George Formby,

Head very strong good proportion, eyes a little loose but no problems. Very good outline and a nice type, strong very good bone, well constructed, kept topline on the move and standing. This dog looks his best in profile, a steady mover.

2 Miller,'s Cyberus The Phantom,

This dog was not as well angulated as the first but has breed type and he moved well. Very good head in proportion with body, top line could be stronger. Well off for bone, good feet.

3 Andrews Cyerus Inxess.

OD (3,1a)

This was not the best class of the day.

1, Baxter, Labaryth Boy Mackenzie for Nobleheart, Res DCC.

He has a very good head correct line and dentition, eye shape and colour good. Is a very good type in profile, needs to strength in pasterns, poor standing and on the move. The best out of the two.

2 Judge's Cyberus I'm An Outlaw at Plushcourt.

Head shape and size ok, eye shape and colour correct. Strong body, construction good but not putting it all to use on the move.

PB (4,1)

One I asked to go as this puppy was having trouble walking in to the ring, (no co-ordination) and I did not think it would be fair to be shown on the day.

1 Dickinson, Mullak Lucretia Lilin BP,

Head is maturing well, has to grow into those ears. Dentition is good, promising head. Well constructed body, good shoulders and rear angulation, good width of thigh, Sound easy movement, will be watching this young lady she must have a great future I hope she matures on and carries on winning.

2 McCulloch & Williams Alonzobar and All That Jazz at Damaco;

No way as mature as first, head and body have a long way to go. You must let her take time to mature do not try to rush her. Nice outline when stood moved well in front.

JB (3)

1 Baxter's Chevelu Honey Bea by Nobleheart Res BCC,

Beautiful bitch not fully mature yet all is going well. Feminine head very good lines, correct eye shape and colour. Well constructed body good angulation, bone and feet. Very sound on the move, this is one to watch.

2 Taylor's Madiellie Skathi.

Another very nice bitch not quite as mature as first but has the same quality, and is very sound on the move. Two very nice bitches, this must be good for the breed.

3 Baker's Cyberus Bewitch Me.

PGB (4,2a)

1 Edwards, Kumormai Platium. BCC and BOB.

This is a very fit young lady, played her handler up, did not keep four feet on the ground to start with, very sound when she got going. Best head oozes breed type a true expression. Very well constructed strong body, good angulation and a dream to watch on the move when she got going, easy steady movement.

2 Swift, Hexnorden Kashmir of Harting.

Head not quite as mature as first but very much the same. Very sound easy movement. The breed must be very proud of these bitches.

OB (2,1)

1 Duval, Chevelu Ivory Blush,

heavy well constructed bitch, very sound moving, very good bone. Head has good width, eyes dark, lids could be tighter, muzzle longer than desired.
