Temperament was good, movement in general is better than a few years ago, but angulation remains a problem. BOB went to the bitch, who was more the finished product.

Vet; (1)

1 Green's Jengais Gunslinger of Barbaro,

8 year old fawn with good bone and good length, moving well. Muzzle could be more square. **BV**

PD (2,1)

1 Green's Alonsobar The One To Watch,

11 months brindle, big headed, big chested youngster, great depth, movement not very smooth. Excellent bone. Very advanced for age. **BP**

JD(1)

1; Baxter's Maharajah Shera By Nobleheart,

16 months fawn with good pigment, fulfilling early promise. At this stage high at the back and needs to broaden in muzzle. Well rounded ribs and good length.

PGD (1)

1 Hazlewood's Kranstaveen Atlas,

3 year old apricot with broad, short head. Good bone. Straight stifles affected rear movement. Chest needs to come down.

LD (4,1)

1 Pennie's Fearnought George Fornby,

3 year old apricot who has come on very well. Huge bone, good length, deep all through. Large, correct head, broad muzzle. Good shaped Mastiff, lacking only a little in angulation. **CC**

2 McKevitts' Cymtysswg Caradog,

4 year old apricot of good quality, deep and broad throughout body, broad skull, but a little cheeky. Rather straight behind and tail set a trifle low.

3 Frew's Klansmun Flavius Vespasian.

OD (3,1)

1 Baxter's; Labaryth Boy Mackensie For Nobleheart,

very large fawn, 4 year old, excellent head, huge bone, broad all through, super type coming into his peak, moved well, only his angulation lets him down. **RCC**

2 Hill's Ch. Farnaby Full Force Of Sobriety

2 year old brindle, tall, good length, stands beautifully, but steep in croup, attractive head, though slow to mature, have seen him move better, and on this occasion lost out to 1st in this regard.

3 Judge's Cyberius Is An Outlaw At Plushcourt.

PB (2)

1; Williams & McCullough's Alonsobar And All That Jazz At Damaco,

11 month fawn, nicely shaped youngster with a promising head, short, broad muzzle. Good angulation. When it came to best puppy, just lacked the maturity of the dog puppy.

2; Allen's Isabella Du Domaine De Straz

11 month fawn, head a long way behind 1st, muzzle is too long and needs to broaden. Angulation and movement very good.

JB (2)

1 Baxter's Chevelu Honey Bea By Nobleheart,

15 month old fawn, still high at the back but a good overall shape, too long in muzzle, good bone, moved well.

2 Taylor's Maddiellie Skath,

14 month old brindle, very immature, nice shape and better head than 1st, but needs more of everything else.

PGB(1)

1; Thompson's Kumormai Manipulation At Thatchra,

2 year old dark brindle, nice deep body shape, well angulated, broad head, good bone.

LB (1)

1 Edwards' Kumormai Platinum,

2 year old fawn, not so interested in showing, mature body of good length, broad head, adequate muzzle.

OB(3)

1 Knight's Kumormai Atonement,

2 year old fawn, litter sister of the previous two class winners, another mature looking bitch, good bone, good length, nice profile, broad head and muzzle, good expression, slightly less than ideal in bend of stifle, but moved very well.

2 Yemm's Secret Charm Avec Dibest,

2 year old fawn, looked slightly less mature than the 1st, but ran her a very close second,; correct length, good bone, attractive head, well shaped body, moved very well, could be a bit more angulated when standing. **RCC**

3 Green's Mansuetude The Chosen One.
