PD (4) Four very good puppies.

1 Chidwick's Cedwalla Augustus.

Well-grown 9 & half-month dog with strong large bone, good square head with mask, nicely arched neck, with good shoulder lay. Chest developing well. Good length of body, muscular hindquarters. Strong hocks, good feet with dark nails. Nice reach and drive on the move. ** BP**

2 Williams & Wilkes' Cwmtyswg Gallant Hero.

Another stunning puppy, well developed head, broad skull showing some excellent qualities. Nice length of neck and shoulder placement. Good straight legs with strong pasterns, good length of body and strong hindquarters but movement cost him first place today. I think these two will probably change places several times in their showing career.

3 Taylor's Cyberus Goliath.

Zaden's Suncamo Son Of A Gun For Faynard.

Stunning strong Fawn with good width and breadth of skull. Well set ears, slight arch of neck developing a deep wide chest, back and loins muscular, giving level topline and very nice rear angulation. Moved well with drive.

2 Knight's Kumorai Echelon.

Another good fawn, strong bone, pleasing head with mask. Nicely set ears, dark eye, moderate length of neck. Good length of back with strong hindquarters. Didn't quite have the drive of No.1 on the move.

2 Smith's Dobunni Mean Mr Mustard

This dog hasn't been shown a lot and just as I was going over him the tanoy went and unsettled him. He settled down and I was then able to go over him. Apricot of good size and substance, strong head and dark eye giving nice expression. Nice length of body with muscular hindquarters. Moved well.

**1 Smith's Dobunni Revolution. **

Powerful strong dog with good broad skull with medium eye and broad muzzle. Muscular neck, well placed shoulders, deep broad chest, nicely sprung ribs. Muscular loins, strong hindquarters. Well-developed 2nd thigh. Kept topline on the move with reach and drive; **R.CC**

2 Weston & Johnson's Cyberus Special Envoy Among Ecotyne.

Very nice Brindle but of smaller statue but in proportion. Moved ok but didn't hold topline on the move

1 Baxter's Labaryth Boy Mackenzie For Nobleheart;

Clear Fawn with broad skull, flat forehead wrinkled when alert, good eye and ear set. Muscular neck and well-placed shoulders. Wide deep chest, elbows well in, good length of back with well sprung ribs, muscular hindquarters. Moved well keeping topline. ** D.CC**

2 Proudfoot & CH. Salforda Sable

Very impressive Brindle with broad head, good square muzzle, lovely dark eye, deep chest, good length of back, well-sprung ribs, strong bone with good pasterns and hocks. I thought he had lost a little of his muscle tone. Moved ok.
