#### **1 Taylor's Cyberus Goliath :**

brindle baby, very serious standing, very jolly on the move. Nice head proportions, good reach of neck, good top line, good bone for his size, good angulation. Lots of promise. **BP**

### **JD(1)**

#### **1 Knight's Kumormai Echelon :**

1 year old with beautiful balance. Excellent bone. Excellent skull proportions, typical expression, dark eye.&nbsp; Good top line retained on the move, ribs developing nicely, good angulation. Delightful character. Moved as well as possible in the circumstances.

### **PGD (2)**

#### **1 Frew's Klansmun Flavius Vespasian :**

mature boy thoroughly enjoying his day out. .Excellent bone and balance. Broad deep chest, excellent spring of rib, good top-line retained on the move, good angulation which helped his movement, the most powerful of the day. Good head proportions, excellent bite, friendly expression.

#### **2 Smith's Dobunni Revolution :**

youngster who found the conditions less to his taste. Excellent bone, good angulation. Still rather adolescent in outline. Body still has to drop. Head is coming. Very promising lad.

### **OD (6,1)**

#### **1 Pennie's Fearnought George Formby:**

Mature balanced apricot with excellent head and body proportions. Broad skull, strong muzzle, lovely expression. Strong neck, excellent top line retained on the move. Good bone, powerful quarters, steady mover, Not very impressed by the whole experience which is so typical of the breed. **BD, BOB.**

#### **2. Clarke's Cyberus Berlington Bertie:**

young brindle with plenty of growing to do. Showed great balance and conformation. Excellent head proportions, good ear carriage, charming expression. Very fluid mover covering the ground with style and purpose when he settled. Wonderful temperament. **Res BD**

### **JB (3:3)**

#### **1 Taylor's Maddielle Skathi :**

brindle girl with good proportions and good bone for her size. Excellent expression, broad skull. Good spring of rib and top line. Steady mover once she settled.

#### **2 Clarke's Camahieu Mabelina :**

apricot , less mature than 1. Good bone, body still immature but developing well. Lovely head and expression. Moved very well.

### **PGB (2)**

#### **1 Thompson's Kumormai Manipulation at Thetchra :**

brindle bitch with good bone and balance. Good head proportions but very sad expression. Good top line and powerful quarters, good angulation and good movement. Still looks immature.

#### **2 Statter's Sarasotasarah at Avadelyon :**

a big brindle girl with wonderful temperament. Mature construction, good spring of rib. Broad skull but muzzle not strong enough to balance. Fantastic mover for such a heavy girl.

### **LB (1)**

#### **1 Edwards' Kumormai Platinum:**

very pretty fawn bitch with excellent proportions. Good body and bone, ribs developing, good quarters, excellent angulation. Feminine head and expression. Moved and showed well. **Res BB.**

### **OB (1)**

#### **1 Knight's Ch Kumormai Atonement :**

mature, well-balanced bitch with very steady temperament who coped far better with the sudden incursion into the ring of a mobility scooter than did her handler. Good body proportions and conformation, excellent rib cage and powerful quarters. Balanced head with strong muzzle, feminine expression. Wonderful feet. Moved very well. **BB.**
