It was a heart searching decision not to award the dog CC but for one reason or another I felt that the dogs did not have enough overall quality to carry the title of champion. Many CCs have been gained by being the best on offer on the day and not always having the required quality to carry the title of champion, and to improve our breed in the future. I felt that eyes need watching as many have a round hard eye which spoils the mastiff expression. On the good side temperaments were good, no animals showing any signs of aggression or nervousness.

### **MPD (2,1)**

#### **1. Taylor's Cyberus Goliath**

Very immature Brindle baby of 6mths would like to see more bone and substance moved O.K.

### **PD (1)**

#### **1. Knight's Kumormai Echelon**

Fawn of 12mths with good strong head of nice proportions well shaped eye giving a kind mastiff expression Well of for bone and substance strong movement in front nice length in side gait but needs to strengthen in rear. **Best Puppy.**

### **JD (3,1)**

#### **1. Simister's Caldermist Earl of Igor**

I really liked this Brindle dog. Well proportioned head and nice flat skull. Good conformation overall and strong bone. Tends to move narrow in front at the moment and stand over angulated behind, when mature and drops in body, he will be more balanced. Nice dog with a future. **BD.**

#### **2. Chadwick's Chevelu Classic Bronze for Pearlian**

Fawn of good size and substance for his age Head a little narrow at the moment nice eye but expression spoilt by light pigmentation moved O.K.

### **PGD(2)**

#### **1. Haughton's Bassma's Horace Rumpole**

Brindle boy of good colour Well shaped head but has a loose eye which distracts in his expression although not a big dog has enough bone and substance for his size Well put together overall moved O.K.

#### **2. Smith's Dobunni Revolution**

Apricot good head and body proportions has a rather straight shoulder which makes him roll in front action but well angulated in rear with strong hind movement.

### **OD(4,1)**

#### **1. Taylor's Chevelu Godric Gryffindor at Tresylyan**

Mature fawn dog of size and substance good head with dark expressive eyes. Good overall body and plenty of bone. Well angulated front and rear and good short hocks moved with ease but then lost his stride giving irregular movement.

#### **2. Baxter's Labaryth Boy Mackenzie for Nobleheart**

Fawn with good head dark eye and good bite Well boned with a solid body would like more length in body to make him better balanced steady mover.

### **MPB (1)**

#### **1. Gittins & Bakers Cwmtyswg Georgia's Girl**

Fawn youngster of 8mths pretty head and nice dark mask Conformation of good proportions which shows in her excellent movement but would like more bone and substance.

### **JB(2)**

#### **1. Baxter's Chevlu Honey Bea by Nobleheart**

Well made strong fawn girl with plenty of substance and good strong bone. Well shaped head and eye but would like a darker mask. Runs up behind in top line, moved steadily.

#### **2. Taylor's Maddiellie Skathi**

Brindle girl who is a good active mover but lacks bone and substance.

### **PGB(2)**

#### **1. Thompson's Kumormai Manipulation at Thetchra**

Lovely Brindle bitch well balanced although. Head of good proportions but spoilt by loose eye and has good sound active mover but does tend to pace at times.

#### **2. Baxter's Norglens Definetly Special at Farnaby**

Fawn bitch with good bone and substance Head O.K but long in foreface and showing her age. Irregular movement.

**LB(3)**

**1. White's Swainsi Mayhem Madness**

Pretty fawn bitch, well put together all a little short coupled, nice eye and expression, but would like more bone, moved well.

**2. Edward's Kumormai Platinum**

This bitch must be her owners nightmare, when she decides to move properly she is very sound, but unreliable today. Nice head and expression, but could have a smaller ear and a flatter skull. Stands on good legs with a body of substance.

**3. Baxter's Norglens Definetly Special at Farnaby.**

**OB (5,2)**

**1. Knight's CH. Kumormai Atonement**

Feminine fawn girl with a good head, short muzzle and dark eye, well proportioned body of substance, well angulated both front and rear, good bone. Moved well and soundly with purpose. **BCC & BOB.**

**2. Duval's Chevelu Ivory Blush**

Bitch full of quality, good head bone and substance, active and sound mover, very close decision, but thought winner held her top line better on the move. **RCC.**
